LUBA WORKERS' COMP REPORTING CLAIMS - LOUISIANA

PROMPT AND ACCURATE BENEFITS ARE OWED TO AN INJURED EMPLOYEE ONCE THEIR CLAIM IS DETERMINED TO BE COVERED UNDER WORKERS' COMPENSATION. YOU MUST REPORT ALL WORK-RELATED ACCIDENTS IMMEDIATELY TO ENSURE PROPER DELIVERY OF BENEFITS. DELAY IN THESE BENEFITS MAY EXPOSE BOTH YOU AND LUBA WORKERS' COMP TO PENALTIES AND ATTORNEY FEES.

When an accident is timely reported, we are able to conduct a prompt investigation into the facts of the accident. Prompt reporting also enables us to control the claim from the beginning, which in turn may lead to cost savings. Once our investigation has been completed, we will pay the claims we owe and defend the claims that are not owed under workersøcompensation. Timely reporting of each and every work-related accident saves you money!

There are 2 types of workersø compensation claims that can be reported:

- 1. Medical Only of These are claims that do not incur indemnity benefits (wage loss benefits).
- 2. Lost Time of These are claims that incur both medical and indemnity benefits.

There are currently 5 ways you may report a claim to us:

1. <u>Report of Injury by Telephone</u> 6 This is the most preferred way to report a new claim. Simply call (888)884-5822 or (225)389-5822 and you will be connected to our intake specialist who will gather all of the claim information from you over the telephone.

We will enter the information on the form for you and once completed, your new claim will go to the proper claims adjuster. This relieves you of the paperwork associated with the reporting of a new claim. We will complete all necessary forms and handle the filings with the Office of WorkersøCompensation. Some of the information you will need when reporting the claim by phone is:

- Employee name, Social Security number, date of birth and any other information regarding your employee
- Date and facts of accident
- Description of Injury/Illness
- Any medical treatment information that may have already taken place
- Class code or job description being paid under

Please make sure you also complete and fax the reverse side, Form 1025ER Employer Certificate of Compliance. Again, we will make the necessary filings with the Office of Workersø Compensation.
